The Burnett School of Medicine has attained Primary and Provisional Accreditation and is now seeking Full Accreditation. Following the site visit, the LCME will determine the accreditation status of the program and provide notification of status in Spring 2023.

THE PRECEPTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

When Providing Feedback – "Labeling" Is Everything!

The Burnett School of Medicine at TCU deeply appreciates all the many contributions our community faculty preceptors make to the education of our medical students. Here are some helpful hints for preceptors on giving feedback to students:

- Deliver praise in public and corrective feedback in private.
- Request the student's permission to deliver feedback. This will allow you to set the tone.
- Try to describe the behavior demonstrated by the student: *"When you spoke to Ms. Smith regarding her diabetes, I observed the following..."*
- "I" statements in feedback delivery (as demonstrated in the previous example) work better than "you" statements.
- When finished with providing the feedback, always say: "That was feedback – do you have any questions for me?"
